














Cyprus' positive economic outlook

- / Cypriot Economy expanded faster than the EU average in 2016 (2.8%)
- / GDP growth of 3.5% in Q2 2017
- / Continuous upgrades by International credit rating agencies
- / GDP growth of around 3% expected to continue (Moody's report, May 2017)





Cyprus' positive economic outlook

- / Consecutive upgrades of the creditworthiness of the Republic of Cyprus by Credit Rating Agencies
- / Successful return to the capital markets at the lowest rates ever achieved by Cyprus in June 2017
- → The bond was oversubscribed by 4 times with offers reaching €2 billion
- / For first 6 months of 2017, property sales contracts increased by 20% compared to same period last year
- → Property sales contracts by foreign buyers recorded an increase of 41,5%
- / Housing prices increased by 4.1% in Q1 2017 compared to Q4 2016

Tax system

Corporate Tax

- / 12,5% corporate tax rate
- / EU & OECD Compliant / Access to EU directives
- / Dividend participation exemption
- / No tax on profits from disposal of securities
- / No withholding taxes
- / No tax on capital gains under conditions
- / Notional Interest Deduction (NID) on investment in Cypriot companies
- / Attractive IP Regime



Tax system

Income tax for new residents Income more than €100K/year

/ Exemption from personal income tax of 50% for new residents

/ Applies for the first 10 years of employment in Cyprus

Income less than €100K/year

/ Exemption from personal income tax of 20%, up to a maximum of €8.550 per annum for 10 years




Tax system

Investor Tax Benefits

/ Non-domiciled individuals who are tax residents of Cyprus are not taxed on passive income in the form of:
